DR. EVELYN DIAS – Dr. Evelyn Dias is the new full-time Liturgical Music Coordinator and Piano Instructor at Divine Word College. Dr. Dias is in possession of a Doctor of Musical Arts (D.M.A.) degree in Piano Performance from Northwestern University in Evanston, IL and an M.A. degree in Piano Performance and Pedagogy from the University of Iowa. She has extensive experience as a church musician in parishes in Iowa City, Evanston, Chicago, Santa Clara, and in Mumbai, India. QUICK HITS

•Academic Partnership Agreement: The respective Vice Presidents for Academic Affairs of Divine Word College (Dr. John Szukalski) and Emmaus Bible College (Dr. Lisa Beatty) signed an Academic Partnership Agreement in August 2018. The purpose of this agreement is to formalize collaboration between DWC and EBC and to enable both institutions to better serve their students in preparation for successful professional careers, globally responsible citizenship, and lifelong learning. This mutually beneficial agreement allows DWC students in Level 8 ESL to audit classes at EBC for language practice purposes, and for EBC students in TESOL to fulfill practicum requirements by observing, practiceteaching, and tutoring ESL students at DWC. •Faculty Institute: The Annual Faculty Institute was held on Monday 13 August 2018 at the Sisters of Charity of the Blessed Virgin Mary (BVM) in Dubuque. Participants included twenty-nine faculty, along with some members of the formation, recruitment, and administration. Dr. Carol Gittens, a consultant and senior research associate with Insight Assessment in San Jose, CA, presented an all-day workshop on Critical Thinking. Improved student performance in critical thinking skills is one area of focus in the 2018-2021 academic strategic plan.

ESL Tutor-Tutee Orientation: An ESL Tutor-Tutee Orientation session was held on Monday 27 August 2018. This was an opportunity for ESL students and tutors to meet each other, set up weekly tutoring appointments, and learn about what to expect (and not expect) about ESL tutoring. Special thanks to the thirteen volunteer tutors from the local community and the ten TESOL practicum students from Emmaus Bible College.

Writing Workshop: Dr. Yasmin Rioux will facilitate a workshop in Academic Writing at 4:00 pm on Friday 7 September 2018. This workshop will explore the basics of APA, Chicago, and MLA citation styles, address different sources and credibility, in-text citations, support for claims in college writing, and the difference between paraphrasing and quoting. Students are encouraged to attend this first of four workshops scheduled during Fall 2018 in the Student Resource Center.

Summer Pastoral Internship Presentations: The Department of Theology & Philosophy and Sr. Theresa-Marie Tran, SCC will sponsor presentations by students who participated in the TRS 295 Summer Pastoral Internship. Each student will deliver brief 10-15 minute presentations about their supervised ministry experiences at 7:30 pm on Friday 7 September 2018 in room 107. All are welcome.

FACULTY PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Dr. Ron Condon, Assistant Professor of Philosophy in the Department of Theology & Philosophy, has been granted sabbatical leave and funding for the Spring 2019 semester. Dr. Condon's research project is on the influence of Ludwig Wittgenstein's late philosophy on the revival and development of the virtue-based ethics tradition in the mid-twentieth century. He will focus particularly on the philosophies of Elizabeth Anscombe, Philippa Foot, John McDowell, and Rosalind Hurthouse. Dr. Condon will return to DWC for teaching in the Fall 2019 semester.
- Ms. Jill Heitzman, Assistant Professor of Music in the Department of Interdisciplinary Studies, has been granted sabbatical leave and funding for the Spring 2019 semester. Ms. Heitzman's research project will include the co-authoring of an online college World Music textbook, which will be published by the National Social

Science Press. Ms. Heitzman will return to DWC for teaching and liturgical ministry in the Fall 2019 semester.

Dr. Evelyn Dias, Assistant Professor of Music in the Department of Interdisciplinary Studies, has been granted professional development funding to attend and present at the California Association of Professional Music Teachers (CAPMT) from 19-20 October 2018 in Torrance, CA. Dr. Dias will present a lecture recital entitled, "Exploring Prokofiev's Forgotten Ballet Transcriptions for the Piano."

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Msgr. Richard J. Schuler Seminarian Award

Catholic United Financial Foundation established the Msgr. Richard J. Schuler Seminarian Charitable Fund in 1996 to honor his 30 years as the Spiritual Director of Catholic United Financial and to commemorate his years of priestly service. Although Msgr. Schuler is no longer with us, his legacy of assisting Seminarians will continue through the Endowment Fund. The application for the 2017 Msgr. Richard J. Schuler Seminarian Award is now available on-line. The application is available on our website. All applications should be completed using the online form. The fund is unique in that it provides support to seminarians in genuine financial need to cover basic living expenses, books, transportation, and/or other incidental expenses, not covered by other sources. Grants are awarded annually to seminarians who are studying for the priesthood in the following Dioceses and Archdioceses: St. Paul/Minneapolis, Bismarck, Crookston, Dubuque, Duluth, Fargo, La Crosse, New Ulm, Rapid City, Saint Cloud, Sioux Falls, Sioux City, Superior, and Winona. The deadline for applications is October 31, 2018. All applications should be directed to the Msgr. Schuler Seminarian Fund.
